Qualifications

Applicant must:

- Be a graduating senior from Buffalo High School or Kaycee High School or be a continuing college student.
- Be a resident of Johnson County at the time the application is submitted.

Graduating applicants must:


- Be enrolled at a community college, university, or vocational school in Wyoming.
- Major in a field of agriculture at the time the scholarship is granted.
- Continuing college students may attend any college of their choice but must major in a field of agriculture.

Application Requirements

- A letter specifically applying for this scholarship.
- A completed application form.
- Two recommendation letters.
- An official grade transcript.
- Eligible to reapply for the scholarship each year.
- Applications must be postmarked or delivered by **April 10th** to:



Selection Guidelines

- Selection will be based on merit and need; however, the recipient must have at least:
A 2.5 GPA on a 4.0 scale.
- No applicant will be disqualified based on sex, race, color, creed, or religious beliefs.


